WHAT IS DRIVE CHIP & PUTT?



"A joint initiative founded in 2013 by the Masters Tournament, United States Golf Association and The PGA of America, the Drive, Chip and Putt Championship is a free nationwide junior golf development competition aimed at growing the game by focusing on the three fundamental skills employed in golf."

By tapping the creative and competitive spirit of girls and boys ages 7-15, the Drive, Chip and Putt Championship provides aspiring junior golfers an opportunity to play with their peers in qualifiers around the country. Participants who advance through local, sub-regional and regional qualifying in each age/gender category earn a place in the National Finals, which is conducted at Augusta National Golf Club the Sunday before the Masters Tournament and is broadcast live by Golf Channel."



The Format: One of our favorite events, a tradition unlike no other is the annual Drive, Chip & Putt event held each April just before the Masters Golf Tournament at Augusta.

- Designed to be a "preparatory experience" for kids aspiring (or just interested) in competing in the national event via local and sectional qualifiers conducted by the PNWPGA Section.
- Provide a fun, exploratory experience for the youngest kids at High Cedars
- We'll provide group (and individualized) instruction on the three disciplines (Driving, Chipping & Putting) during the first three weeks of the program
- On the fourth week, April 9th, we'll bring it all together and conduct our own "local DCP Championship" right here at High Cedars. Just like the actual event that will be held on June 10th!, We'll follow the same format and have prizes/awards both boys and girls in several age groups (6-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14) depending on number of participants!

The Schedule: Learn and develop the fundamentals of DCP during the first three weeks of prep clinics, then compete in the High Cedars Golf Club "DCP Club Championship" (formatted just as the 2018 local DCP qualifiers will be later this summer). Each group will be limited to first 12 students (ages 6-14).

- Option 1 Schedule: Monday, March 19-April 9 @ 4-5:30 pm (Chris Ming)
- Option 2 Schedule: Tuesday, March 20-April 10 @ 4-5:30 pm (Chris Ming or Scot)
- Option 3 Schedule: Saturday, March 17-31 @ 3pm - 4:30 pm (Sara)

The Fees: \$125 per junior

- Fees include three 90-minute clinic sessions on DCP fundamentals, entry fees and prize fund for the High Cedars DCP Championship
- *Championship DCP event for Club will be on April 9th*
